Commissioner Beasley made a recommendation to accept the Forney Community Park Master Plan Low Level Summary Recreation /Senior Center Allowance in the amount of \$15,000,000.

Commissioner Price made a motion to accept this recommendation. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Sanders. The motion passed with 6 ayes and 0 nays.
