Summary Statement:

This project scope was for the construction of a new 750,000-gallon composite elevated water storage tank. The new capacity was necessary to support the growth in the City and to provide peak hour water demands and fire protection in the City.

The project is in the final closeout phase as all work has been completed. A two-year maintenance period becomes effective once approved and accepted by City Council.

There were no change orders on this project and the overall project cost came in under the estimated budget.
