RESOLUTION NO. 20-_____**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FORNEY, TEXAS AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF FORNEY AND THE CITY OF GRAND PRAIRIE FOR THE PROVISION OF HOLIDAY LIGHT DISPLAYS AND RELATED SERVICES DURING THE HOLIDAY SEASON; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENGAGE CUSTOM HOLIDAY LIGHT DISPLAY SERVICES AND TAKE ALL ACTION NECESSARY TO COMPLY WITH THIS RESOLUTION; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Forney, Texas (the "City") sought proposals under RFP 20-001 for the design, construction and purchase of Holiday Light Displays to be on display at Community Park during the holiday season; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to execute an Interlocal Agreement for Holiday Light Displays to be leased for display during the holiday season and for the provision of related services for the installation, take down and storage of the displays; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to approve Mosca Design, Inc. as an alternate vendor for custom holiday light displays.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FORNEY, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. The above and foregoing premises are true and correct and are incorporated herein and made part hereof for all purposes.

SECTION 2. The proposals for RFP 20-001 Holiday Light Displays are effectively rejected as to the original scope of services.

SECTION 3. The City Manager is authorized to execute an Interlocal Agreement Between the City of Forney, Texas and the City of Grand Prairie, Texas for Provision of a Holiday Lighted Outdoor Drive-Through Display.

SECTION 4. The City Manager is authorized to engage the services of Mosca Design, Inc. for any additional custom holiday light displays to be designed, constructed and purchased by the City of Forney.

SECTION 5. This Resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage.
