**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FORNEY, TEXAS  
ELECTING A MAYOR PRO TEM FOR THE CITY OF FORNEY FOR A PERIOD  
OF ONE (1) YEAR; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, Section 3.04 of the City Charter of the City of Forney, Texas provides for the City Council to select from among themselves a Council member to serve as Mayor Pro Tem of the City of Forney; and

**WHEREAS**, Section 3.04 of the City Charter provides the Mayor Pro Tem the authority to act as Mayor during his/her disability or absence and in this capacity, shall have all the rights conferred upon the Mayor and shall still be entitled to vote as a Council member; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council members of the City of Forney voted and selected \_\_\_\_\_ to hold the position of Mayor Pro Tem for a period of one (1) year at a duly posted meeting of the City Council.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FORNEY, TEXAS:**

**SECTION 1.** That the above findings are hereby true and correct and are incorporated herein in their entirety.
