Item Summary:	

Mr. Craig Smiley, representing the property owner, requests approval of a final plat for Brookville Estates, Phase 2. The purpose of the final plat is to establish the boundaries and easements necessary for the development of a single-family residential subdivision.

Current Standards:

The 43.875-acre property is currently vacant and undeveloped. The property is located to the south of the new Forney ISD Middle and Intermediate School and the property is located north of the first phase of the Brookville Estates single-family residential subdivision. The preliminary plat was approved by City Council on February 16, 2021.

Final Plat:

The final plat consists of one-hundred and fifty-five (155) single-family lots and six (6) open space lots. The plat is designed in compliance with the Brookville Estates Planned Development. The Planned Development Ordinance was amended by City Council in October, 2020, to provide standards for the development of Phase 2.

The development standards include SF-8 as the base zoning district. The average lot area for this plat is 8,755 square feet, with 76% of the lots being over 8,000 square feet in size. This meets the zoning requirements for the property.

Staff Recommendation:

Staff recommends approval of this request, as presented. In addition to Community Development staff, the plans were reviewed by the City Engineer, Fire Marshal and Public Works staff.
