**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FORNEY, TEXAS  
APPROVING AN AGREEMENT DESIGNATING RETAIL WATER SERVICE  
TERRITORY AND TRANSFERRING FACILITIES AND CUSTOMERS BY AND  
BETWEEN THE CITY OF FORNEY, TEXAS AND THE CITY OF MESQUITE,  
TEXAS; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, on September 22, 2020, the Cities of Forney and Mesquite executed a Memorandum of Understanding for the purpose of defining expectations and responsibilities of the parties related to Mesquite's acquisition of Markout Water Supply Corporation's water system and its customers and the division of that system and service area;

**WHEREAS**, on August 16, 2021, the City of Mesquite closed on its acquisition of Markout Water Supply Corporation's water system; and

**WHEREAS**, the Cities of Forney and Mesquite will commence the transfer of service area currently in the city limits of Forney, acquired by the City of Mesquite through the acquisition of Markout Water Supply Corporation, to the City of Forney.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FORNEY, TEXAS:**

**SECTION 1.** The proposed Agreement Designating Retail Water Service Territory and Transferring Facilities and Customers by and between the City of Forney, Texas and the City of Mesquite, Texas is hereby approved.

**SECTION 2.** A substantial copy of the Agreement is attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein for reference.

**SECTION 3.** This Resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage.
