Item Title: Consider a Resolution awarding a contract to Prime Controls for the SCADA upgrade services and all related issues.

Item Summary:

On July 06, 2021, City Council approved the project and for staff to move forward with the RFP (request for proposals). We stated at this time that we intended to select a firm to provide us with a quote for assessment, to perform the assessment, provide a quote for the necessary upgrades, perform the upgrades, and help maintain the system after installation. This was to be consistent and uniform as this is a large project that has already taken a year to get to this point. We also brought this project back to City Council on July 6, 2021, to approve a contract for the assessment portion of this project.

Scope of Work: Prime Controls will be adding updated missing SCADA components, upgrading outdated components, and moving SCADA off of the City server onto its own stand-alone system. This work will occur at all water and sewer stations and the Public Works office.

The contract rate is not to exceed \$466,829. Any additional services beyond the original scope of work are subject to review and acceptance by the City Manager before any costs are incurred.

Funding is available in the Capital Utility Fund for the project.

Staff is recommending approval of a contract.
