I. CALL TO ORDER

Mayor Lewis called the meeting to order at 6:01 p.m. Present were Mayor Amanda Lewis, Mayor Pro Tem James Traylor and Council Members Cecil Chambers, Sandi Primous, Sarah Salgado, Zahnd Schlensker and Jason Roberson. Also present was City Manager Charles Daniels.

II. CONSENT AGENDA

1. Consider approval of the acceptance of public improvements for the Fox Hollow 2B subdivision project.

Mayor Lewis called for a motion on Consent Agenda Item No. 1. Mayor Pro Tem Traylor made a motion to approve the acceptance of public improvements for the Fox Hollow 2B subdivision project and Council Member Roberson seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously by a vote of 7 ayes and 0 nays.

III. WORK SESSION

1. Discussion of the updated bond projects and possible action.

Bryan Wyatt of WRA presented the updated numbers for the projects and Nick Bulaich of Hilltop Securities presented the tax implications of the bonds.

Mayor Pro Tem Traylor made a motion to recommend to the Bond Counsel the Fire Station Projects at a cost not to exceed \$45.8 million and Council Member Roberson seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously by a vote of 7 ayes and 0 nays.

Council Member Chambers made a motion to recommend to the Bond Counsel the Parks Projects at a cost not to exceed \$68.8 million and Council Member Roberson seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously by a vote of 7 ayes and 0 nays.

Council Member Roberson made a motion to recommend to the Bond Counsel the Recreation Activities Center Project at a cost not to exceed \$46.0 million and Council Member Salgado seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously by a vote of 7 ayes and 0 nays.

Mayor Pro Tem Traylor made a motion to recommend to the Bond Counsel the Library/Community/Senior Center Project at a cost not to exceed \$21.5 million and Council Member Salgado seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously by a vote of 7 ayes and 0 nays.

Mayor Pro Tem Traylor made a motion to recommend to the Bond Counsel the Road Projects at a cost not to exceed \$52.7 million and Council Member Salgado seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously by a vote of 7 ayes and 0 nays.
