- **Time for Completion.** All construction or installation work authorized by this permit must be completed in the time specified in this construction permit. If the work cannot be completed in the specified time periods, the Permittee may request in writing an extension from the City Engineer before the permit has expired. Work may continue pending a decision by the City Engineer on the extension request.
