BOND PROJECT UPDATE



In partnership with WRA Architects, Inc., City staff and a bond committee representative highlighted four areas for public consideration for the upcoming November Bond- Public Safety, Parks and Recreation, a Library/ Community/ Senior Citizens Center, and Transportation Infrastructure. City Council was presented revised construction numbers, and in turn gave direction on some minor revisions. Final numbers and taxpayer impact will come back to Council in a month. An education for the public with an interactive website design and other multiple tools will be available in the coming months to help residents understand and ask questions about each project.
